# **SERMON - SHERRYL KOOP**

# **Coming Together - Ephesians 2:1-10**

In this section of Paul's letter to the Ephesians he speaks of what Jesus' followers were before following Jesus and then the gifts that come with following him - grace and mercy! However as followers of Jesus, does this ring true for us in how we love one another? Does this ring true in how we see ourselves before Christ? Some questions we will ponder together!

They were Catholic and this prayer was so important to them. We prayed that prayer together every time I visited them and it took on new meaning for me.

Last weekend we used the Lord's Prayer in both our Good Friday and Easter services. This is a very comprehensive prayer and it guides us through many important facets of our faith. You may have memorized it in school many years ago, but we don't often use it in corporate worship. I encourage us to continue to use this prayer in our walk with Jesus.
